

## JYNNEOS and TPOXX: Quick Storage and Handling Guide

JYNNEOS	TPOXX
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The vaccine is stored at the depot and transferred frozen (-15 to -50C).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The capsules are stored at the depot and transferred at room temperature.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The vaccine should be thawed before administration. Due to the small dose quantity, it thaws very quickly.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A copy of the chain of custody form will be provided to you upon delivery.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Thawing is preferably done in the refrigerator, unless the patient is present and waiting for the vaccine.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Each bottle of TPOXX contains 42 capsules.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do not have at room temperature for more than 30 minutes, or potency of the vaccine may be affected.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Capsules should be stored in original bottle. Do not open bottles for redistribution.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Once thawed, do not refreeze.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Store at 20 to 25C</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The vaccine is viable in the refrigerator once thawed for 8 weeks from thaw date.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>TPOXX is dosed by weight in kg, and requests for treatment should be for 1, 2, or 3 bottles depending on quantity required for the 14 day course.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No dilution required. This is a single use vial.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Study protocol must be followed</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This vaccine should not be transported without recording transfers in TennIIS and using a DDL / AccuCold Portable Unit or similar appropriate vaccine transport equipment.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Consult with TDH at <a href="mailto:monkeypox.treatment@tn.gov">monkeypox.treatment@tn.gov</a> for any questions or concerns regarding treatment with this drug.</li> </ul>
